

You've noticed, and have been very patient with all of the work being done around the golf course and public areas. Here's an update on our progress.

Behind the restaurant is the Fountain Garden, once part of the original estate that was on the property. The Fountain Garden is completed and open to all who want to use it. The only thing missing is the actual fountain, which is on order.

Alongside the restaurant is the Great Lawn, which is also finished; however, it may not be used yet as the ground cover is thin and there's a lot of weeds. The plan is to maintain this area as a grass field for several years until the weeds are gone. Then, we'll introduce wildflowers to create a beautiful meadow for all to enjoy.

The walking trails can be accessed from each of these areas and the trailheads will soon be marked by signs.

### **Improvements to the golf course include:**

#### **First Tee:**

This tee now has topsoil and root zone mix. Sod will be placed soon and the new cart path prepped.

#### **7 Tee:**

This tee will be top soiled and have root zone mix by the end of this week. We hope to have the upper tee open for this weekend.

#### **18 Tee:**

We hope to have the mid and back tees open for this weekend.

#### **4, 8 and 9 Tees:**

4<sup>th</sup> hole bunker and new grass hollow and 3 new grass hollows on 8 and 9 will be sodded this week.

#### **8 Green:**

Bunkers will be shaped this week with new bunker drainage all possibly starting this week.

#### **9 Tee:**

The extra length of cart path has begun to be excavated.

#### **9 Hole:**

Fairway bunker is roughly shaped.

The greenside bunker on 9, fairway bunker on 8, path at the 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> greens and mounding at the bottom of 7 are all that remain on that section of the course.

Remaining to be done are the 3<sup>rd</sup> tee box, 3<sup>rd</sup> bunker, 4<sup>th</sup> tee box and the cart paths that will go around the back of the 3<sup>rd</sup> green.

Thank you for bearing with us as this construction is impacting play at certain times. We will continue to try and get all work done as soon as possible.
